

TO HONOR SAINT TODAY

**Italians Here to Begin 3-Day Feast
of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.**

Italians in lower Harlem, joined by fellow-countrymen from all parts of the metropolitan district, will begin today a three-day celebration of the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. The actual feast day is Thursday.

In the neighborhood of Second Avenue and 115th Street, home of one of the largest Italian communities in the city, streets last night were bright with festoons and arches of electric lights, gaily decorated pushcarts, fluttering bunting.

In the Church of Our Lady of Mount Carmel all preparations were complete. High mass will be celebrated there tomorrow and thousands of city pilgrims will wend their way through the streets with lighted candles, symbols of the flame of faith, to be left at the altar.

Peddlers, vendors of sweetmeats and cool drinks have their carts dressed for the feast day. There may be a fireworks display, too.

Similar celebrations will be held in other Italian neighborhoods where there are churches dedicated to Our Lady of Mount Carmel.
